



### *Overview*

The following is a capsulation of activities and accomplishments of the Village of Solway Police Department for the year of 2021

The Village of Solway Police Department has adopted a philosophy of community policing and a total commitment to service. During 2021, the police department has had its challenges with the COVID 19 pandemic coming to be a norm in today's society. Almost all community projects such as Neighborhood Watch meetings, Senior Citizen Meetings, that were put on hold due to the pandemic have slowly come back to include Coffee with the Chief. During this time, the police department was still able to protect and serve the community of Solway. Through it all, the Solway Police Department remained committed to the excellence in policing and meeting the needs of our community

During 2021, the department received the following:

Revenue from court fines and other fees taken in for the 2021 year was a total of **\$144,391.00**

The Solway Police Department made a total of **833** arrests, which **32** were DWI arrests, and **60** were Juvenile related for 2021. The department responded to **10,012** calls for service, conducted **689** follow-up investigations, issued **2096** Vehicle and Traffic Tickets, issued **1574** Parking Violation Tickets, and investigated **126** Motor Vehicle Collisions.

The Solway Police Department also collected a total of **\$56,057.00** in parking fines for the calendar year of 2021. This was a **45% increase from 2020**. These fines continue to include past due fines from over an eight-year period. This is all due to the fact that back in 2016, the department was able to place Scofflaw Restrictions on outstanding violators. The Scofflaw prevents violators from renewing and registering any vehicle in their name until all fines are paid in full. The department also started to send those who were unable to be placed on the Scofflaw list, into Judgment Status with the Onondaga County Clerk's Office. Judgment status puts those outstanding violation on a credit reporting list, which could affect both their ability to receive any type of loans and/or credit cards from some banks. With these tools, the department hopes to continue collecting outstanding parking fine revenue for the 2022 calendar year. With the help of the Scofflaw, that is the reason for some of the increase in this year's fine revenue. Most registrations are coming up for renewal, forcing those with the Scofflaw in effect to pay their fines in order to keep their registrations in effect. Next year will see more come due as well.

During 2021 the Police department is still down one (1) officer due to injuries (Dennis Macholl), Officer Edward Gesser was able to retire in 2021, after a long time of being out of work due to his injuries he received while on duty. Officer's Joseph Hardy and Tyler Hemingway were hired part-time in June of 2021.

During July of 2021, Officer James Difulio resigned from the Solvay Police Department to go work for another police agency, and Lieutenant Derek Osbeck was promoted to the position of Chief of Police after Chief Allen Wood retired. We wish both former Chief Wood and Officer Difulio Good Luck in their future endeavors.

In October of the same year, Sergeant Robert Cross was promoted to the position of Lieutenant and Officer Matt Ryan was promoted to the position of Sergeant. He will be supervising officers on the A-Watch shift. Also, Officers Joseph Hardy and Tyler Hemingway were promoted from part-time officer status and to full-time status in October. Officer Hardy will be assigned to A-Watch and Officer Hemingway will be assigned to C-Watch. Please refer to the attached Chain of Command for a full command level assignment.

The police department's goals for 2022 are to continue to improve our community policing efforts and improving our services to the residents of Solvay through training. The department is currently looking to appoint two part-time officers in 2022, to fill the positions that were vacated by Officers Hardy and Hemingway.

The department also purchased five new vehicles in October in order to help improve our fleet of aging vehicles. Hopefully, we will be hosting a Course in Police Supervision, an Instructor Development Course and a Field Training Officer Course in 2022.

The department is looking forward to possibly starting a Citizen's Police Academy in the late summer or early fall of 2022. The goal is to help further the community policing efforts as well as educating residents on how, not only the Solvay Police Department operates, but how the Criminal Justice system works as a whole. The academy is looking to tentatively give those attending a chance to tour both the Onondaga County Emergency Communications Department (911) and the Onondaga County Sheriff's Office Justice Center. As always, the department will continue to explore alternative resources for funding, both at the State and Federal levels, and work toward providing the most cost-effective means in which to provide expected levels of service to the citizens of the Village of Solvay







# Arrest by Month 2021




# Arrest by Category 2021




# Sick Time by Hours 2021




# Sick Time by Days 2021



# Sick Time by Hours Two Year Comparioson 2020 vs 2021




**Sick Time by Days

2020 vs 2021**









# UTT's Issued by Month 2021






**UTT's Issued by Year


